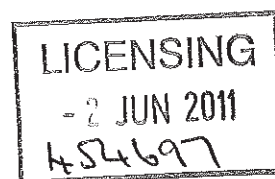



Hi Ewen, having looked at section 162 again with our solicitors, our understanding is that subsection (2) only applies if a responsible authority (RA) or interested party (IP) have made a representation. As we do not have any representations from a RA or IP we still believe this should be placed before a sub-committee in accordance with 162(1)(c).

Therefore we are proposing if you are in agreement, that we will ask our sub-committee due to meet on the 30th June for another hearing of an LA03 application if they will determine the application for us.

This is to ensure that we have followed the correct procedure on this occasion, if it should be challenged by the Gambling Commission.

Louise

Further to our telephone conversation, I note what you say in relation to s.162 (1).

If you read through the remainder of that particular section, at s. 162 (2), the Licensing Authority may determine the application without a hearing, notwithstanding ss. 1 with the consent of the applicant and any person who has made a representation.

The authority would therefore be perfectly entitled to determine this application without the need to hold a hearing, as it did with a similar application for Sol Centrale some time ago.

I can also confirm, as I explained to you on the telephone, we have made a number of similar applications across the country in relation to our other casinos, and in none of these has it been necessary for the Authority to hold a hearing.

On the assumption that there are no representations to this application I can confirm that we would be content for the Licensing Authority to determine the application without a hearing.

If there are any representations then we would reserve our position in relation to dispensing with the need for a hearing.
