- Reason for Hearing to be outlined by the Licensing Officer or the Chair.
- Format of the hearing an explanation of the format of the proceedings:
  - 1. **Applicant** (or his/her representative) will address the sub-committee first and put their case.
  - 2. **The Chair** leads an examination of the **Applicant's case.** First, the panel may ask questions and then the Chair invites Responsible and Interested Parties to participate. Questions may only relate to the points made by the applicant.
  - 3. **The Representors** (and responsible and Interested Parties) then state their case.
  - 4. The Chair leads an examination of the Representor's case.

Each party will be given an equal maximum period of time in which to present their case and may, if given permission by the Chair, question any other party.

- **Sub-committee retires** and may call for the Solicitor for advice if required.

Please state the ground(s) for review (please read guidance note 1) On behalf of the Chief Officer of Police Mr Lee, I call for the Review of the Premises Licence for the Plough Hotel, Northampton. I call for the Review under the Licensing Objectives of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder and the Protection of Children from Harm.
On the 30 <sup>th</sup> of September 2011 Northamptonshire Police conducted a Test Purchase Opertaion at the premises using two 15 year old children, the operation was in relation to underage sales of alcohol. On this occasion alcohol was purchased by the Test Purchase Operatives, two bottles of WKD Vodka. The seller was dealt with by
way of a Penalty Notice for Disorder to the sum of £80.00, this ticket has been paid. The Manager was spoken to on the evening in relation to a member of his staff
selling alcohol to two minors.  On the 21 <sup>st</sup> of October 2011 Northamptonshire Police conducted a Test Purchase Operation at the premises using two 15 year old children, the operation was in
relation to underage sales of alcohol. Again on this occasion alcohol was purchased by the Test Purchase Operatives, two bottles of WKD Vodka. The seller was the
Manager who was a Personal Licence Holder, this person was invited voluntarily to Campbell Square Police Station to be interviewed at a later date.  On the 6 <sup>th</sup> of December 2011 the Manager was interviewed under caution and in
accordance with P.A.C.E. at Campbell Square Police Station. The Manager has received a caution in respect of the sale of the alcohol he made to the minors.
Also on the 6 <sup>th</sup> of December 2011 the Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor Mr Bhupinder Dhaliwal was interviewed under caution and in
accordance with P.A.C.E. voluntarily at Campbell Square Police Station. He has been reported for the offence of Section 147a of the Licensing Act 2003, Persistently
Selling Alcohol to Children.
