



(i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the perod in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or

(ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act;

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the pruchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-

(i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or (ii)the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

2. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).



#### ANNEXES continued ...

3. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

The following mandatory conditions are to be applied to the licence stated above in accordance with section 3 (1) of The Licensing Act 2003 (Mandatory Licensing Conditions) Order 2010.

#### The following conditions shall come into force on 1st October 2010

4. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

5. The responsible person shall ensure that-

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having ben made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-

- (i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

further to my email yesterday concerning the above application.

I have given the matter further thought and, recalling that the building opposite the premises has been converted to residential on the upper floors, I have concerns that the proposals could cause a nuisance to them.

I note that 60 Bridge street is a conventional building with large single glazed windows and double-hung sash windows and is not purpose built as a place of public entertainment.

Therefore, I have serious concerns that the building will be able to contain music noise at an entertainment level without causing a noise nuisance to the flats opposite.

It may be that the building is listed and or in a conservation area and modification to the windows will not be permissible and thus render noise insulation schemes impractical. Such a scheme could also include a major ventilation and eir-con system that could have a significant effect on the external appearance. Similarly, such an installation might encounter resistance from the planning department.

Therefore, until the applicant can provide credible evidence that the proposals will not give rise to a public nuisance (affecting the flats opposite), with or without a practicable noise control scheme, I must re-instate our objection to the proposal.
