9. INSTALLATION OF PHOTO VOLTAIC PANELS TO REDUCE THE ENERGY BILLS TO COUNCIL TENANTS

- 1. Cabinet supported, 'in principle', the proposed installation of PV panels via a Roof Access Agreement and the fixing of third party equipment to the roofs of suitable council homes until ownership of the equipment switches to the Council after 20 years, subject to the Roof Access Agreement being amended to reflect the undertakings described in Paragraphs 3.2.16 and 4.2.5 of this Report and Northampton Partnership Homes monitoring the work undertaken on council homes to ensure that it is completed to a high standard; and
- 2. Cabinet delegated to the Chief Executive and the Section 151 Officer (in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Housing & Wellbeing) the authority to determine that the requirements set out in Paragraph 4.3.2 of the report have been met and approved the Roof Access Agreement, the fixing of third party equipment to the roofs of the Council's homes for a period of 20 years and, subject to the conditions in paragraph 2.1 of the report, authorised Northampton Partnership Homes to appoint Saliis Renewables Limited to carry out the PV installation work.
