### 1. Purpose

1.1 This report seeks Council's approval of the number and Group proportionality of seats on each Committee.

### 2. Recommendations

- 2.1 That Council approves the number of seats on each Committee as set out in the report.
- 2.2 That the representation of the political groups be as set out in this report

### 3. Issues and Choices

### 3. Report Background

- 3.1 The current composition of the Groups is 25 Conservative Members, 17 Labour, and 3 Liberal Democrats.
- 3.2. The Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and its associated regulations, requires the Council, at its annual meeting, or as soon as practicable afterwards following any changes to its political makeup, to review the representation of political groups and determine the allocation of seats (ie proportionality). The rights of the various political groups are specified in relevant regulations.
- 3.3. The following principles need to be applied in allocating Committee places:
  - 3.3.1. That not all seats on any Committee or Sub Committee are allocated to the same political group

- 3.3.2. that the majority of seats on all Committees and Sub- Committees are allocated to the political group that has a majority of the Council's membership or as otherwise reflects the make-up of the Council;
- 3.3.3. that subject to 3.3.1. and 3.3.2 above, the number of seats for all main Committees which are allocated to each political group bears the same proportion to the total of all the seats on the main Committees as is borne by the number of members of that group to the membership of the Council; and
- 3.3.4. subject to 3.3.3 the numbers of seats on the individual Committees and Sub Committees allocated to each political group bears the same proportion to the number of seats of that Committee as is borne by the number of members of that group to their membership of the Council.
- 3.4 There are 70 allocated Committee places which divides as 39 Conservative, 26 Labour and 5 Liberal Democrats.
  - 3.4.1 The allocation of seats between the Committees is as follows:




