  1. **Applicant** (or his/her representative) will address the sub-committee first and put their case.
  2. **The Chair** leads an examination of the **Applicant's case**. First, the panel may ask questions and then the Chair invites Responsible and Interested Parties to participate. Questions may only relate to the points made by the applicant.
  3. **The Representors/Respondents** (and responsible and Interested Parties) then state their case.
  4. **The Chair** leads an examination of the **Representor's case**.

Each party will be given an equal maximum period of time in which to present their case and may, if given permission by the Chair, question any other party.

## **NEW GRANT PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION –**

### **Licensing Sub-Committee**

#### **1.0 Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 To consider an application for the new grant of a premises licence. Mr Sarbaz Amin Abdullah in relation to the new grant of a premises licence for 166-168 Lutterworth Road, Northampton, NN1 5JL.

#### **2.0 Summary**

- 2.1 An application for the new grant of a premises licence was submitted by Licensed Intuition on behalf of the proposed licence holder and designated premises supervisor Mr Sarbaz Amin Abdullah. The application was received by Northampton Borough Council on the 10<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Mr Abdullah is the licence holder and designated premises supervisor at two other premises within Northampton.

As part of the applications operation schedule, the applicant has also submitted a number of steps that the licence holder has agreed to implement in order to promote the licensing objectives.

#### **3.0 Application Details**

- 3.1 The application was submitted with the intention to licence the premises in order to trade as a Restaurant/ Café style business licensed to sell Alcohol ancillary to a meal and provide late night refreshment.
- 3.2 The licensable activities and times requested on the application are for the following;

**Sales of Alcohol for consumption On the premises:**

Monday – Sunday 08:00 – 00:00 Midnight

**Late Night refreshment:**

Monday – Sunday 08:00- 00:00 Midnight

**Opening Hours:**

Friday – Sunday 08:00am – 00:00 Midnight

- 3.3 The proposed Designated Premises Supervisor is:

#### **4.0 Consultations/Representations**

- 4.1 When a request for the new grant of a premises licence or club premises certificate is received, the applicant must display a notice at or near the premises and serve a copy of the application onto the responsible authorities. For electronic applications it is a requirement of the local authority to serve a copy of the application onto the responsible authorities.

This gives responsible authorities and interested parties the opportunity to make representations in relation to the application for a period of 28 calendar days. The last date for representation was the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2017.

- 4.2 The obligatory notice was displayed on the premises as verified by licensing officers on the 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2017 and in a local newspaper on the 19<sup>th</sup> October 2017.
- 4.3 The Licensing Department has received one relevant representation under the licensing objective of public nuisance from a resident of Lutterworth Road.
- 4.4 Northamptonshire police have considered the application and have come to an agreement of the licence conditions.
- 4.5 Environmental Protection have considered the above mentioned premises licence application pertinent to the licencing objective of the prevention of public nuisance. The condition recommended is that only background music can be played during permitted opening hours.

#### **5.0 Attendance**

- 5.1 The local authority is required to send a notice of hearing to all interested parties and request confirmation of attendance. A notice of hearing was sent to the following persons on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2017.

## **7.0 Options**

7.1 At the end of the consultation period the licensing authority must hold a hearing. It must take such steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives, which are:

- the prevention of crime and disorder
- public safety
- the prevention of public nuisance
- the protection of children from harm

The steps the Sub-Committee can take are to:

- reject the application;
- grant the licence subject to modifying the conditions of the licence (excluding the mandatory conditions);
- refuse to specify an individual as a designated premises supervisor;
- exclude from the scope of the of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates.

premises where there is no need for such conditions. Standardised conditions should be avoided and indeed, may be unlawful where they cannot be shown to be necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives in any individual case.

I have received a copy of the above premises licence application. While I have no objection in principle to this licence being granted, I would appreciate the wording of some of the proposed conditions being altered slightly and as below:

- 1) A fully working and maintained CCTV system capable of recording and storing images must be installed on the premises. The system must record at all times the premises s open to the public and images must be stored for a minimum of 28 days with date & time stamping. As a minimum this must cover all entry and exit points, both sides of all areas where the sale/supply of alcohol takes place.
- 2) All recordings must be made available to an officer from a responsible authority upon reasonable request and in line with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998.
- 3) All staff involved in the retail of alcohol will be trained in relation to the law regarding its sale. This training must be completed prior to them being authorised to sell alcohol and refreshed every 12 months as a minimum. A record of this training must be kept and maintained with a copy of the syllabus attached. The recipient of the training must sign to state that they have received and understood the training and this should be dated. Training records must be kept on the premises at all times and made available to an officer from a responsible authority upon reasonable request.
- 4) Customers must not take open vessels of alcohol from the premises at any time unless there is an authorisation such as a street café licence in place. Where such an authorisation is in place open vessels of alcohol must not be taken beyond the boundaries indicated by the licence.
- 5) The premises will operate and adhere to an age verification scheme with the minimum standard of Challenge 25. Signs advertising the policy must be displayed in all areas where alcohol is for sale.

This will be a like for like swap of the relevant conditions you have already proposed just as a way of clarifying some of them.

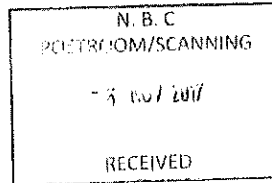

**Alcohol Licence Application – Arayn Coffee Wellingborough Road/Lutterworth Road**

We are writing to object to the terms of the Alcohol Licence application for the above premises and particularly with regard to the hours for which the application has been made.

The premises is a coffee shop open from 8.00 am until 6.00pm, but the application is to serve alcohol until at least midnight. This changes the nature of the premises totally.

Our objection is on two grounds:-

Firstly, on the grounds of public nuisance. The premises is on the corner of a residential street. There is already an issue with noise late at night at the weekends due to the close proximity of the various bars, pubs and restaurants on the Wellingborough Road.

This will be made worse by a licensed premises immediately adjacent to residential properties.

Further, there is no smoking area for the premises. Customers to a coffee shop are likely to stay no longer than an hour or so and are unlikely to feel the need for a cigarette. Customers eating and drinking alcohol are far more likely to stay for a longer period and are more likely to want to smoke. This will no doubt create an informal smoking area on the Wellingborough Road or more likely in Lutterworth Road and quite possibly around the entrance to the back of the shops and the flats at the top of Lutterworth Road. This will create noise and a nuisance.

Secondly, on the grounds of the cumulative impact of the large number of existing licences already granted. There are already 4 shops (Tesco Express, European Supermarket, Premier and Co-Op), 2 restaurants (Mensaab, Transylvannia, Imrans) and then Corkers all within close proximity, that is before you reach the pubs, ie. Pickering Phipps, Lighthouse, Crown and Cushion etc further down the Wellingborough Road.

The area is awash with a variety of premises selling alcohol in various forms, with and without meals and a further licence is unnecessary and excessive and will have an adverse effect on the area and the residents in it.

Please arrange to put these objections forward and we await hearing from you further.
