The concept of a "key decision" is intended to capture the most important or significant decisions. Key decisions will be made at meetings which will be open to the press and public. The press and public may only be excluded from such meetings as and when the Council's monitoring officer decides that this is necessary in order to avoid the public disclosure of confidential or exempt information (as legally defined). A key decision is defined as a decision which is likely:

- a) to result in the local authority incurring expenditure or the making savings in excess of £250,000 and/or
- b) to be considered significant in terms of its effect on a community

Anyone wishing to make representations that this matter should be discussed in public, should do so by not later than 12 Calendar Days prior to the meeting, using the details below:
