

<u>Listed below our my reasons for objecting to Premises Licence Application, 23 Charnwood Avenue, Westone, Northampton as follows:</u>

The alcohol licence would be totally unwelcome as residents fear that this would encourage vandalism, noise and bad behaviour especially late at night. This is a quiet residential estate with most people retiring early at night.

In the past when there was a shop, we suffered serious litter problems, bottles thrown over garden walls, can stuffed into hedges, glass smashed and even eggs thrown at windows! Also during school hours gangs of children left lots of litter and used peoples walls for seats and smoked there. When they were asked to move on they were verbally abusive, often dislodging the coping stones in several instances.

Additionally, persons occupying the maisonettes above the proposed shop would be affected by possible noise and bad behaviour.

As Weston Favell Centre is so near, we no longer need a shop. Also we have an excellent mobile shop who comes round Westone regularly for elderly persons not able to get out.

The walkway between Charnwood Avenue and Lumbertubs Way is an ongoing problem having had muggings there and a great deal of noise and abusive behaviour late at night and we are all agree that to have licenced premised would encourage 'undesirables' from other areas to take advantage of the late night licensing hours and this is totally unacceptable in our opinion.

Having lived in Charnwood Avenue for 48 years, it would be very sad to witness any further deterioration when we all try hard to keep our homes and neighbourhood in peaceful order.
