# **Specific Comments**

- Majority supportive and welcome NLES
- Over 90% feel key measures in NLES are important/very important
- Specific issues:
- Public awareness, bus and taxi standards, cycling & walking provision, Council leadership, spatial planning, support for electric vehicles, Low Emission/Clean Air Zones
- Specific issues (outside of NLES scope):
  - Discourage cars from Town Centre/need for north orbital road
  - Modal shift to public transport/cycling and walking
  - Prevent wood burning, including biomass CHP
  - STRONG OBJECTIONS TO INCINERATOR (20%)

## Separate Stakeholder Responses

- Northamptonshire County Council (Highways)
  - Smart Transport Projects
  - Liaison on electric vehicle charging infrastructure
- Northamptonshire County Council (Public Health)
  - Suggested amendments to NLES
  - Inclusion of more standards/targets/timetable
- Highways England
  - Funding support for measures on Strategic Road Network (SRN), inc. M1, A45, A43
- Northamptonshire Green Party
  - Clean Air Zones/Low Emission Zones
  - Stronger spatial planning measures covering all Northampton urban area
  - Support for cleaner buses/electric vehicles/cycling/park & ride
- Hardingstone Parish Council
  - Low Emission Zones
  - Stronger spatial planning measures


#### NLES actions since consultation

- Agreed a minimum Euro IV emission standard with Stagecoach and Unobus from 2018. Need to look at further standards going forward
- Consultation underway on setting emission standards as part of taxi licensing
- Consideration of OLEV funding for ultra low emission taxi infrastructure and demonstration schemes
- Response to Ministers letter outlining local activity to improve air quality and request for more action at a national level
- Government consultation on the proposed National Clean Air Zone (CAZ) Framework
- Discussions with NCC regarding development of Ultra Low Emission Hub demonstrations on major development schemes

## Recommendations

- With consideration of consultation responses, prepare final Northampton Low Emission Strategy (NLES) for adoption by Council, including detailed delivery plan (measures/standards/roles & responsibilities/timetable and funding)
- Consider whether the scope of the NLES should including non-road transport issues eg chimneys
- Adopt NLES Air Quality & Emissions Planning Guidance
- Develop a public awareness scheme concerning air quality and the impacts on health, issues affecting local air quality and measures that can tackle the problem
- Introduce emission standards as part of public sector Social Value procurement
- Consider undertaking a feasibility study regarding the introduction of a Clean Air Zone (CAZ) or Low Emission Zone in Northampton, including:
  - bus and taxi emission standards
  - consideration of standards for other vehicle types
  - promotion of low and ultra low emission vehicles, including provision of infrastructure, through development of ultra low emission hubs
  - consideration of publicity and signage
  - consideration of enhanced funding potential
