On behalf of the Chief Officer of Northamptonshire Police Mr ADDERLEY, I call for Review of the Premises Licence under the Licensing Objective of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

The basis of this review is as a result of a joint Police and Trading Standards inspection of the premises which took place on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2018. This visit followed information that watered down vodka was being sold on the premises.

As Officers were entering the premises, the owner of the shop was just arriving in a van and entered at the same time. Inside was a male shop worker who was stacking the shelves.

This worker was later found to have overstayed in the UK and has been served deportation papers. He has no right to work in the UK.

During the interactions with him, both he and the owner of the shop provided Police false details as to the identity of the worker however his identity was eventually discovered when he was arrested, taken to the Police Station and had his fingerprints taken.

The Police have concerns that the premises licence holder of the premises was present at the time of the incident and either took steps to provide false details of his worker to Police or had no idea of the true identity of the person he had employed to work for him indicating that no checks on his right to work had been made.
