What is Community Safety?

"Community safety means preventing, reducing or containing the social, environmental and intimidatory factors which affect people's right to live without fear of crime and which impact upon their quality of life. It includes preventative measures that contribute to crime reduction and tackling anti-social behaviour."



What is Hate Crime?

- Hate Crime Any Crime that is perceived by anyone to be motivated by hatred or prejudice against someone's race, religion, gender identity, sexuality or disability
- Hate Incident Any Incident that is perceived by anyone to be motivated by hatred or prejudice against someone's race, religion, gender identity, sexuality or disability

Aims of policy and procedures
