

**NEW GRANT PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION –
Licensing Sub-Committee
Tuesday 29th May 2018**

1.0 Purpose of Report

- 1.1 To consider an application for the new grant of a premises licence by Mr Amed Ismael Khudhur in relation to a premises at 167 St James Road, Northampton, NN5 5LE.

2.0 Summary

- 2.1 An application for the new grant of a premises licence was submitted by the proposed licence holder and designated premises supervisor Mr Amed Ismael Khudhur. The application was received by Northampton Borough Council on the 5th April 2018.

As part of the applications operating schedule, the applicant has also submitted a number of steps that has agreed to implement if the licence is granted in order to promote the licensing objectives.

3.0 Application Details

- 3.1 The application was submitted with the intention to licence the premises in order to trade as an off licence business licensed to sell Alcohol to be consumed off the premises. A copy of the application appears at **Appendix A**.
- 3.2 The licensable activities and times requested on the application are for the following:

Sales of Alcohol for consumption OFF the premises:

Monday – Sunday 08:00 – 23:00

Opening Hours:

Friday – Sunday 08:00am – 23:00

- 3.3 The proposed Designated Premises Supervisor is:

4.0 Consultations/Representations

- 4.1 When a request for the new grant of a premises licence or club premises certificate is received, the applicant must display a notice at or near the premises and serve a copy of the application onto the responsible authorities. For electronic applications it is a requirement of the local authority to serve a copy of the application onto the responsible authorities.

This gives responsible authorities and interested parties the opportunity to make representations in relation to the application for a period of 28 calendar days. The last date for representation was the 3rd May 2018.

- 4.2 The obligatory notice was displayed on the premises as verified by licensing officers on the 13th April 2018 and in a local newspaper on the 12th April 2018. A copy of the notice appears at **Appendix B**.
- 4.3 The Licensing Department has received three representations under the licensing objection of public nuisance/crime and disorder. One representation from a resident of Weedon Road, Northampton and two residents of Melbourne Road, Northampton. Copies of the representations appear at **Appendix C**.
- 4.4 Public Health have suggested additional conditions to be added to the licence if granted and the applicant has agreed to accept these. The suggested conditions appear in **Appendix D**. Even though the applicant has indicated his agreement to accept those conditions, it is still for the sub-committee to decide whether they should be added to any licence granted.

5.0 Attendance

- 5.1 The local authority is required to send a notice of hearing to all interested parties and request confirmation of attendance. A notice of hearing was sent to the following persons on the 15th May 2018 (waiting for confirmation date).

7.0 Options

7.1 At the end of the consultation period the licensing authority must hold a hearing. It must take such steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives, which are:

- the prevention of crime and disorder
- public safety
- the prevention of public nuisance; and
- the protection of children from harm

The steps the Sub-Committee can take are to:

- grant the licence;
- reject the application;
- grant the licence subject to modifying the conditions of the licence (excluding the mandatory conditions);
- refuse to specify an individual as a designated premises supervisor;
- exclude from the scope of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates.

8.0 Policy Considerations

9.0 Committee

Each application must be considered on its own merits and any conditions attached to licences and certificates must be tailored to the individual style and characteristics of the premises and licensed activities concerned. This is essential to avoid the imposition of disproportionate and overly burdensome conditions on premises where there is no need for such conditions. Standardised conditions should be avoided and indeed, may be unlawful where they cannot be shown to be necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives in any individual case.

Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives

a) General – All Four Licensing objectives, (b,c,d and e)

- The licence holder shall operate and maintain a refusals register in respect of declined sales of alcohol where the attempted purchaser was suspected of being under 18 years of age or drunk.
- The refusals register shall be kept on the premises and be made available immediately upon request to an authorised officer of the Police or Local Authority.
- The licence holder will ensure that within six weeks of any appointment of a member of staff, they receive adequate training in responsible alcohol retailing and refreshed every 12 months. A training record will be kept at the premises.
- There will be no sales of beer lager, or cider over 6% ABV.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV

1. A fully working and maintained system capable of recording and storing images must be installed on the premises. The system must record at all times the premises is open to the public and images must be stored for a minimum of 28 days with date & time stamping. As a minimum this must cover all entry and exit points, both sides of all areas where the sale/supply of alcohol takes place.
2. All recordings must be made available to an officer from a responsible authority upon reasonable request and in line with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998.

Staff Training

3. All staff involved in the retail of alcohol will be trained in relation to the law regarding its sale. This training must be completed prior to them being authorised to sell alcohol and refreshed every 12 months as a minimum. A record of this training must be kept and maintained with a copy of the syllabus attached. The recipient of the training must sign to state that they have received and understood the training and this should be dated. Training records must be kept on the premises at all times and made available to an officer from a responsible authority upon reasonable request.

Nuisance

4. Signs will be displayed at the exit points of the venue requesting that customers respect local residents by leaving and dispersing from the premises and immediate area quietly and in an orderly manner. Staff will take all practical steps themselves and work with Northamptonshire Police and Northampton Borough Council in deterring groups of people from gathering in the immediate area outside the premises and causing harassment, alarm or distress.

Age Verification

5. The premises will operate and adhere to an age verification scheme with the minimum standard of Challenge 25. Signs advertising the policy must be displayed in all areas where alcohol is for sale.
6. A refusals register will be kept on the premises for the recording of any incidents involving the refusal of a sale of alcohol due to age or drunkenness. The register will be made available to an officer from the local authority for inspection upon reasonable request

Miscellaneous

7. Spirits must be displayed behind the sales point and will not be available for self-service.
8. There will be no sales of beer lager, or cider over 6% ABV.

c) Public Safety

- The premises will conform to all statutory health and safety Requirements

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Persons shall be discouraged from congregating outside of the premises.
- A notice will be placed immediately outside the main entrance reminding persons that no alcohol to be consumed directly outside the main entrance to the shop.
- The licence holder shall operate and maintain a refusals register in respect of declined sales of alcohol where the attempted purchaser was suspected of being under 18 years of age or drunk.

e) The protection of Children from harm

- The challenged 25 scheme will be implemented
- To ensure that any person selling or supplying alcoholic drink under the authority of a personal licence holder follows the guidelines of the Challenge 25 scheme and asks for photo ID proof of age where they have reason to suspect that the individual may be under 25 years of age and to ensure that signs relevant to this condition are prominently displayed at the premises.

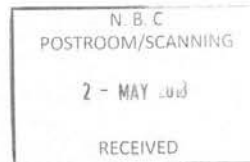
There is also already 2 late night alcohol selling places in very close proximity to this address also with Aldi & Iceland we have more than enough places to buy alcohol.

In addition, in this small area we also have Aldi and Iceland, which also sell alcohol, and yet another convenience store (with alcohol) behind Aldi. I believe that the granting another licence for a premises to sell alcohol, will be of a detriment effect to the local non-drinking local residents who wish to attend their business and shops without nuisance. We already have groups of people gathered around drinking alcohol, this leads to anti-social behaviour, can be intimidating to local residents and causes additional rubbish in the area. 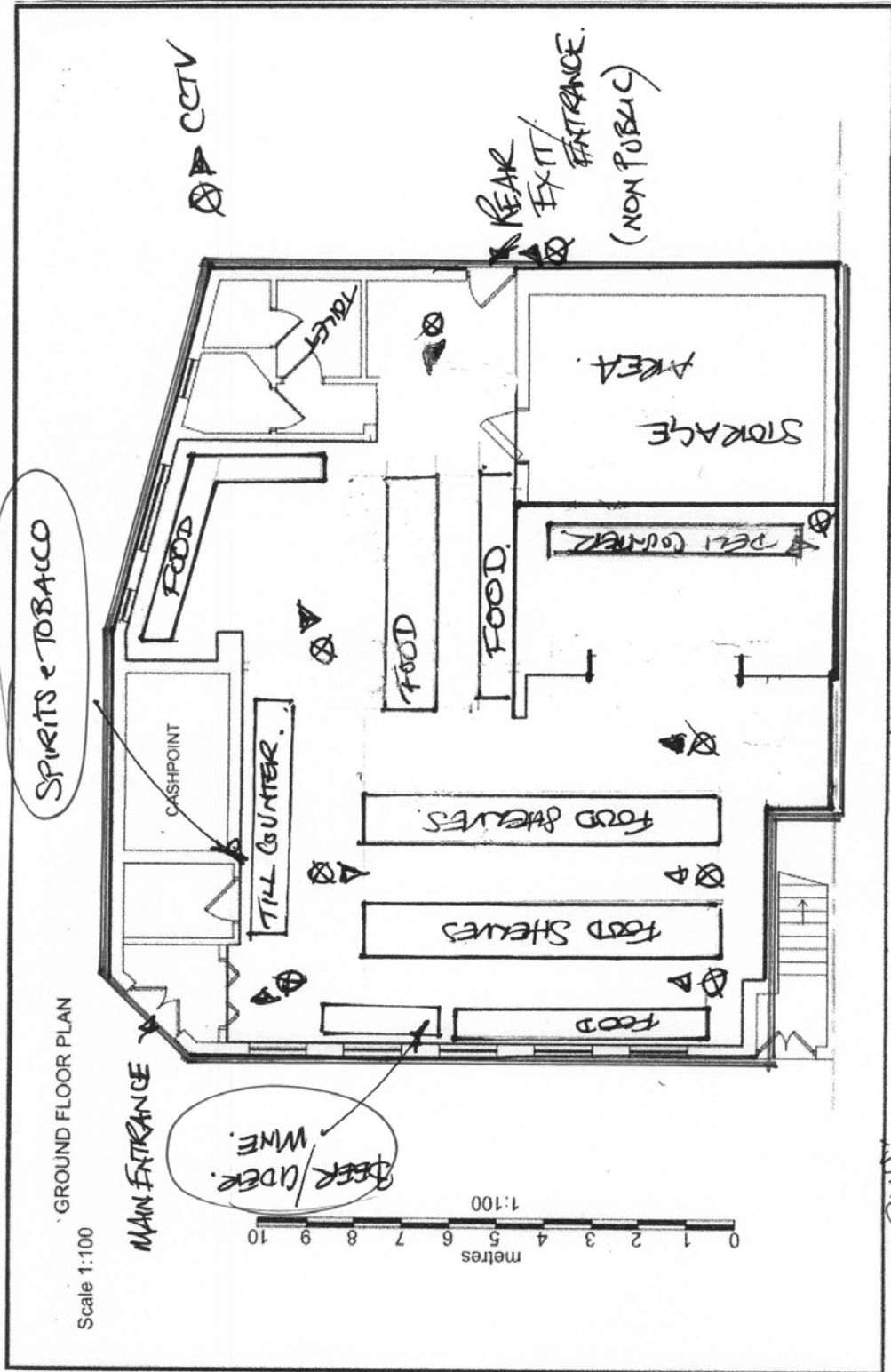
