Northamptonshire Police a responsible authority has applied for the REVIEW of a Premises Licence under Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of King David Public House, Newnham Road, Northampton NN2 7RE.

The grounds for the review are to secure the Licensing Objectives of Preventing Crime and Disorder, Public Safety, the Prevention of Public Nuisance and the Protection of Children from Harm due to incidents at the premises.
