This council has on several occasions expressed concern about the inadequate facilities for coach passengers and operators provided in Victoria Street.

The Cabinet response was that better facilities were planned as part of the Greyfriars redevelopment.

Given that we have recently been told that the Greyfriars project may take up to 10 years to complete has the Cabinet member for Regeneration and Enterprise any plans to restart discussions on the future of our international coach terminus?

Response

Replacing the coach facilities on Victoria Street are a priority and discussions are taking place as part of the work on the Future High Street Fund bid. This along with improved connections to the Greyfrairs site remain the first elements of delivery likely on the Greyfriars site.
